The golf season is now in full swing. The course has recovered well from the drought and severe storms that pummeled the area. We have addressed the water problem caused by last year's drought by installing a pumping capability to bring water from the lake on #1 to the main lake on #13. Jeff and his crew have also made several improvements to the course. Please take a moment to thank them for the outstanding job they are doing. .. To keep the course in great shape, please repair ball marks on the greens and utilize the sand bottles provided to repair divots around the course. (Fixing your own plus one or two others would certainly help)

We have 311 members, including the 43 new members that have joined since last spring. The continued expansion of our membership is critical to our success in keeping costs down. If you have friends or neighbors that you think might be interested in joining please bring them out to play a round and get them a membership application. Currently there are no initiation fees. A guest can play PCC a maximum of 5 times in a calendar year. Members must be present and sign in their guests.

We have leased 25 new electric golf carts that will cut our overall costs. Our fleet will soon be all electric. These are state of the art carts that we are sure you will enjoy.

From the Course Manager – Jeff Gates

This has been a busy month of cutting. We were able to accomplish some of our projects this month. The greens have been aerified and by the end of the first week of May they should be rolling pretty well. We were able to get the areas soiled and seeded where we installed the pipe from the old pump house on 1 to the irrigation pipe on 13. We also got the area cleaned up and seeded where we installed the water line to the waste treatment plant and the area on the top of 11 fairway where we installed the new irrigation heads. The Bunkers on 3 have been tended to. We seeded the bunker behind the green, this bunker was a maintenance nightmare and we couldn't seem to get enough sand in it. The bunker on the left hand side was constantly washing out, so we brought in 4 gator loads of top soil and sodded over that. Mostly we have been keeping up the grass, I realize the rough is tall but I can assure you we are trying our best to keep up with it.
